Frequently Asked Questions

Group – Scheduled Lunch & Dinner Cruise Enquiries

Please note special payment and cancellation conditions may apply to special offers.

Can some of my guests pay for a bar package and some not?

No. Bar packages are discounted and are only available to your entire booking.

What if I have Concession or Children in my group?

Group 10% discounts can be applied to full priced Adult, Concession & Child fares. It is not valid with any other special offer.

Does everyone get a window seat?

A finite number of window seats are available on vessels which means on busy days not all passengers can be allocated window seats. A surcharge applies per person (depending on the cruise selected) to guarantee a window seat. Pre-booking is essential.

When do I need to pay?

A 50% deposit is required at the time of booking and final payment is required 14 days prior to sailing.

Group Cancellation & Date Changes

For Groups of 10 or more passengers all payments are final and non-refundable however the following considerations will be made on request (excluding special events):-

- One date change is permitted (subject to fare level availability) without penalty, if notified 7 days or more prior to travel. Any difference in cruise price is payable by the group. Additional transfers incur a \$20 per person fee.
- Passenger numbers may reduce by 10% up to 2 hours prior to travel with the balance credited towards the bar account or another cruise within six months of the original date of travel.

Where do cruises depart from?

Some cruises offer a choice of departure points and these may include

- Circular Quay – No.6 Jetty
- Darling Harbour – Pier 26, next to the Sydney Aquarium
- Darling Harbour – No.1 King Street Wharf, approx 8 minutes walk north of Sydney Aquarium

Do I need to advise where I will be boarding?

We recommend you advise our Reservations staff where you will be boarding. If you are booking a group, please ask all of your guests to board from the one location.

Check-in & Boarding

Boarding passes must be collected at least 30 minutes prior to departure from the company's ticket offices at No.6 Jetty Circular Quay (9am to 7pm daily), Pier 26 Aquarium Wharf Darling Harbour (9am to 5pm daily) or No.1 King Street Wharf (open 1 hour prior to cruise departure times) or as otherwise advised. Boarding commences approximately 15 minutes prior to sailing (approximately 30 minutes prior for Gold Dinner passengers)

How do I get to my cruise?

Circular Quay and Darling Harbour are very conveniently located near most city hotels and major city bus, rail, ferry and taxi stations. We do not offer hotel transfers however your hotel concierge can assist with directions. For self-drive, there are many parking stations in the Circular Quay and Darling Harbour precincts. What is the dress code?

Smart casual for Breakfast, Lunch, Sunset Dinner & Starlight Dinner Cruises. For all other Dinner Cruises we recommend Smart & Stylish (jackets for men).

Can we bring our own drinks?

All our vessels are licensed premises. We do not permit BYO.

What if we are celebrating a birthday, anniversary or other special occasion?

Many of our passengers choose to celebrate special occasions aboard our vessels and your waiter can arrange a sparkler to accompany your special guest's dessert (a la carte dining only - not available with buffet menus). Alternatively you might like to bring your own small celebration cake on the day. Please note due to safety restrictions on vessels, candles are not permitted.

Are there facilities for Children?

All children must be escorted by adults. Children are welcome to cruise, however please keep in mind that you are on the vessel for up to 3.5 hours and sometimes children do get restless. Infants travel free of charge (no meal provided) and there are a limited number of booster seats available. A Children's Menu is available on Dinner Cruises offering a small selection items including chicken nuggets, chips and ice cream (pre-booking essential - minimum 24 hours notice required). We do not offer a special Children's Menu on buffet or lunch cruises.

What if it is raining or the weather is bad?

We operate in sheltered waters, 365 days a year, regardless of the weather. All Dining seating is situated inside the vessel in comfortable all-weather surroundings with expansive viewing windows.

Is there a photographer on board?

During Lunch & Dinner Cruises a photographer will take photos of your group and have the pictures available for purchase at the end of the evening. There is no obligation to buy.

Do we need cash onboard?

For all Lunch & Dinner cruises except the Buffet Lunch, drinks purchased onboard are charged to your bar account and will need to be settled prior to disembarking. Payment can be made with Cash, Credit Card or Australian Travellers cheque. Bar Package options are available for an extra charge (pre-bookings essential). On the Buffet Lunch drink orders should be settled with your waiter at the time of order.
